

Attention All Demarest Families!

Demarest School District is now using an autodialing system to notify district families of school emergencies, closings and special events. Except in cases of emergency, such as school closings, no calls will be made before 7 a.m. or after 9 p.m. The system is designed so that families with multiple children in the district will only get one call. However, Northern Valley Regional High School has its own system. If you have children in the K-8 schools and the high school, you might get two calls for certain announcements.

We recently conducted a test of the system for DMS and LLE. Some families reported not getting phone calls. It is extremely important that you ensure your child's school has your current home telephone number.

When you receive a call from our system, Demarest Boro or Demarest School District will show on your caller ID. After the message plays, you will be prompted to press "1" to verify receipt of the message. If you take the time to press "1", it will help us ensure that all messages are being delivered. If you do not answer the call, the system will deliver messages to answering machines and voice mail systems. If the system is unable to deliver a message the first time, it will attempt a total of 5 calls before stopping.
