

EXPENDITURES/EXPENDING AUTHORITY

Within the framework of applicable laws and regulations, purchases and use of materials and manpower shall be accomplished in accordance with good business practices with the primary purpose to serve the instructional program.

The Demarest Board of Education shall not knowingly enter into contract with any company which does not subscribe to and implement an affirmative action policy. The affirmative action officer shall execute this policy in written administrative directives.

The business administrator/board secretary shall request from the treasurer of school moneys the funds needed in accordance with statute, code and case law requirements, and local agreements.
