

PUPIL VEHICLES

Students in grades 2 through 8 may use their bicycles to travel to school if:

- A. They have their parents/guardians written permission;
- B. The bicycle is licensed by the local police.

Students who ride to school shall follow the rules prescribed by the State Division of Motor Vehicles and the borough regulations including the mandatory wearing of helmets.

Students shall have the privilege to operate or store their bicycles on school grounds rescinded if they regularly ride in a manner that endangers their own safety or the safety of others. Bicycles must be locked in the appropriate bike rack as the school will not assume responsibility for any damages that may occur.

Mopeds, skateboards and scooters are not permitted on school grounds under any circumstances.
