

SAFETY PATROLS

The board believes that student safety patrols can contribute greatly to the development of good traffic habits and can provide opportunities for growth in leadership skills. Safety patrols may be formed when, in the principal's opinion, the students are mature enough to participate.

Therefore, the chief school administrator shall develop regulations for the formation of safety patrols.

These regulations shall include, but not be limited to, provision for:

- A. Informing candidates and their parents/guardians of the purpose and activities of the patrol and the possible hazards;
- B. An outline of duties suitable to each school building;
- C. Cooperation with the police.
