

NONSCHOOL USE OF DISTRICT VEHICLE

The Norwood Board of Education has made the buildings and grounds of the district's public school available for nonprofit community use, provided that in the opinion of the Chief School Administrator such use would not conflict with, impede or negatively affect the operation of any school-related activities. However, the sole school vehicle, a pick-up truck, shall not be made available for non-school or personal use.

However, the Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds may assist local the municipal Department of Public Works (DPW) in a cooperative venture if approved by the board. There are times when it may be mutually beneficial for the truck or other equipment to be shared with the DPW and the board encourages cooperation to share services as possible.
