

Pupil Vehicles

Pupils in grades three through eight shall be permitted to ride their bicycles to school.

The district shall not be responsible for bicycles while they are on school property.

The use of motorized vehicles shall not be permitted by pupils. Skateboards and rollerblades are also prohibited.

Bicycles

In the interest of safety, students below the third grade may not ride to school on a bicycle.

Children in grades three through eight should always wear helmets, ride on the right side of the road with traffic; keep as close to the curb as possible; ride single file when with a group; never carry a rider.

Racks are provided for care of bicycles ridden to school. Bicycles should be placed in racks on arrival and not taken from racks until departure. Students must provide their own locks. Bicycles should not be ridden on the school grounds. Children should dismount at the sidewalk and walk their bicycles to the rack. Bicycles may not be borrowed or loaned without permission of the owner. All parents/guardians are urged to make this very clear. Violators will be denied the privilege of riding their bikes to school.

Mini bikes, skateboards, roller skates, etc. are not permitted on school property at any time.
