

DESIGNING/ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING SERVICES

All plans and specifications for school building work of any nature, by law, must be prepared by an architect, a mechanical engineer or structure engineer registered to practice in the State of New Jersey and within the limits covered by such registration.

The Board of Education's criteria for the selection of architects and engineers to be employed by the school district will be such as to ensure a high degree of competency. Selection of architects/engineers for each project will be made by the Board of Education.

The Chief School Administrator shall, through appropriate delegation, be responsible for:

- A. Developing criteria applicable to the selection of architects and similar professionals for Board of Education approval;
- B. Recommending specific firms from the approved list for each project.

In continued development of the sites of existing facilities, the Superintendent shall propose means to minimize hazards and nuisances.

The Board will contest any zoning or use changes that could affect the health or welfare of the students attending district facilities.
